We are proud to announce that we had 57 students score highly proficient in ELA and 91 students score highly proficient in math. AIMS science is tested in fourth grade, and we had 29 fourth graders exceed the test expectations on that test. We continue to strive for excellence in all we do and are happy to report that our students and staff are continually doing the same.

Safety is our primary concern. As such, we've instituted a lot of new procedures in the past two years.
